Saatbau is an important breeder, seed producer and trader specialised on the needs of European farmers. One of their main crops are soybeans. In Weikendorf they run an experimental station for soya breeding.

The Feller family runs a farm that plants and propagates soybeans for Saatbau.

Travelling by public transport

Vienna Underground: U1 - Station Kaisermühlen VIC, 2 minutes walking from the station (go straight between DC Tower and UN City). The Hotel Lenas Donau is just one metro stop away from VIC.

Travelling by car

To get to the Austria Center Vienna by car, take the A22 motorway and turn off at the Austria Center Vienna/ VIC (Vienna International Center) exit. Alternatively, take the Reichsbrücke bridge or approach from Wagramer Strasse. There is ample private on-site parking in the garage of ACV.
